Description: The primary purpose of this position is to evaluate and recommend requests for new construction, renovation and improvements of base facilities including utility systems. This position is required to use and apply technical mechanical engineering knowledge in; developing, preparing, monitoring, and maintaining programming documents which will include major project design reviews. The post will ensure the safe and efficient running of all plant equipment and distribution systems relating to Heating, ventilation, air conditioning, hot water, energy management, remote/automatic generators and invertors on RAF Alconbury and RAF Molesworth.

The successful applicant will coordinate projects with engineers in a variety of disciplines and/or with architects. The successful applicant will work with organizational managers, budget personnel, and engineering/architectural authorities to develop and gain approval for proposed facility programs/projects.

Applicants must provide detailed work experience as it relates to the required competencies listed below, as this will be used to determine your qualification for this position.

1. General and practical knowledge of engineering concepts, methods, principles, practices and techniques' familiarity with engineering disciplines (mechanical, electrical, structural, utilities, etc.).
2. Knowledge of program planning and budgeting cycles, financial control, and budget systems; work classifications and the regulatory and statutory restrictions on the expenditures of funds; automated data processing system capabilities and economic usage to effectively accomplish assigned functions.
3. Knowledge of standard contracting regulations, practices, and procedures.
4. Knowledge of analytical and diagnostic methods, procedures, and principles and surveying methods, equipment, and techniques of measurements to identify project requirements.
5. Ability to plan and record site/facility surveys and inspections.
6. Ability to research, analyze, interpret, and apply rules, regulations, codes of practice and procedures in a variety of situations and recommend timely and economical solutions.
7. It is highly desired that the incumbent holds HND/HNC/BTEC, City and Guilds, NVQ or equivalent technical qualification in a discipline, together with a minimum of three years work experience in the trade. A bachelor's degree is not required
8. Must be GAS SAFE registered and trained to correct ACOPS standards in order to competently plan work for projects involving gas fuelled installations.

OTHER SIGNIFICANT FACTORS:

1. Work may occasionally require travel away from the normal duty station. May be required to travel by military/commercial vehicle and commercial aircraft
2. May be assigned other duties not described in this position description, but that are appropriate to the grade and skill set of the incumbent.
3. The work may require the employee to drive a motor vehicle. Must possess an appropriate and valid driver's licence.
4. The position requires the knowledge of numerous regulations and codes of work. Attendance at various courses may be required to keep up to date with new practices, materials and safety legislation.
