Description: The primary purpose of this position is to evaluate and recommend requests for new construction, renovation and improvements of base facilities including pavements and masts & towers. This position is required to use and apply technical structural and civil engineering knowledge in; developing, preparing, monitoring, and maintaining programming documents which will include major project design reviews. The post will work on projects that are often associated with a wide variety of architectural and engineering facets which interface with other technical specializations and are moderately complex. The successful applicant will coordinate projects with engineers in a variety of disciplines and/or with architects. The successful applicant will work with organizational managers, budget personnel, and engineering/architectural authorities to develop and gain approval for proposed facility programs/projects.

Applicants must provide detailed work experience as it relates to the required competencies listed below, as this will be used to determine your qualification for this position.

1. General and practical knowledge of engineering concepts, methods, principles, practices and techniques' familiarity with engineering disciplines (mechanical, electrical, structural, utilities, etc.).
2. Knowledge of program planning and budgeting cycles, financial control, and budget systems; work classifications and the regulatory and statutory restrictions on the expenditures of funds; automated data processing system capabilities and economic usage to effectively accomplish assigned functions.
3. Knowledge of standard contracting regulations, practices, and procedures.
4. Knowledge of analytical and diagnostic methods, procedures, and principles and surveying methods, equipment, and techniques of measurements to identify project requirements.
5. Knowledge of industrial roofing and cladding systems, road & pavement construction and overall building & civil engineering processes and technologies.
6. Ability to plan, perform and record site/facility surveys and inspections.
7. Ability to research, analyze, interpret, and apply rules, regulations, codes of practice and procedures in a variety of situations and recommend timely and economical solutions.
8. It is highly desired the applicant holds City and Guilds, NVQ or equivalent technical qualification in an appropriate discipline, together with a minimum of three years' experience in the trade.
9. The incumbent of the post must hold, or be capable of becoming an AP Working at Heights and Confined Spaces within the probation period.
10. Knowledge of management of asbestos containing materials and lead based paint.

OTHER SIGNIFICANT FACTORS:

1. Work may occasionally require travel away from the normal duty station. May be required to travel by military/commercial vehicle and commercial aircraft
2. This position is located primarily at RAF Fairford but will be required to provide similar support at RAF Welford
3. May be assigned other duties not described in this position description, but that are appropriate to the grade and skill set of the incumbent.
4. The work will require the employee to drive a motor vehicle. Must possess at a minimum Cat B license.
5. The position requires the knowledge of numerous regulations and codes of work. Attendance at various courses may be required to keep up to date with new practices, materials and safety legislation.
6. Work may occasionally require extended hours or overtime in the event of a need to support an emergency response or a mission support need.
7. The position will be the designated Roof Program Manager requiring working at heights to perform roof condition inspections.
8. The position will be the designated Operations and Maintenance of Asbestos Containing Materials / Lead Based Paint Plan manager and alternate POC for the overarching ACM /LBP Management Program.

WHO CAN APPLY: Citizens of the UK, Nationals of European Community (EC) Countries, and Commonwealth Citizens, other Foreign Nationals, and Stateless persons provided no restrictions have been imposed as a condition of continued residency in the UK. Proof of identification in the form of a photo ID will be required, for example a Driving license or current passport. All successful applicants will require a security clearance.
