They will perform heavy mobile equipment mechanic work including troubleshooting malfunctions, determining the type and extent of repair" required, repairing, and maintaining equipment including 25,000 (25K) and 60,000 (60K) pound capacity aircraft platform loading deck cargo loaders, bulldozers, excavators, front loaders. power shovels, road graders, dump trucks, and mobile cranes. Repairs, overhauls, tears down/rebuilds, modifies, and maintains a variety of systems and components whilst conducting functional and performance tests on completed work products using a variety of test procedures and equipment.
