RAF Mildenhall are looking to recruit a Plumber to perform a full range of plumbing duties to include installing, repairing, and modifying water supply, sewage disposal, and similar utility systems and equipment using various tools. You will also troubleshoot/test various plumbing systems and equipment including backflow prevention devices as well as utilizing safety practices and procedures. The role also involves maintaining clean water distribution and exterior sewer collection systems.

Knowledge and Experience Required - Applicants must demonstrate the following:

City and Guilds/NVQ Level 2 in an appropriate discipline is required for this position or combination of education and experience. Knowledge of and experience performing equipment assembly, installation, operation and repair, to include routing, placement, slant, slope, and fall of systems; and of technical practices in order to plan, lay out, install, modify, troubleshoot, and repair various systems and equipment.

Knowledge of and experience applying and enforcing safety regulations, procedures and practices.

Skill in installing, modifying, and repairing new and existing utility, supply, and disposal systems and equipment without more than normal supervision.

Knowledge of technical practices in order to perform various operational repairs and preventive maintenance on potable water treatment & wastewater treatment systems; and of potable water distribution systems, and sewer collection systems. Skill in using and maintaining tools and equipment such as rules, levels, plumb bobs, dividers, various gauges and meters, various drain cleaning devices, hydrostatic pumps and torches.

Skill in troubleshooting difficult or hard-to-detect leaks and operating problems. Ability to use shop mathematics, take measurements, and lay out angles, arcs, and circles.
