You will act as design and construction manager for projects and programs as well as providing support to design and construction agents in negotiating agreements with contractors and other agencies. You will develop, review, and manage contracts for engineering projects and services and function as senior engineer with major program responsibility and ensure that projects meet required standards as far as sufficiency, technical feasibility, energy efficiency and cost. You will conduct special research and investigations into engineering problems for which there are no established precedence and establish new procedures where necessary. You will also recommend cost effective solutions to engineering challenges and provide supporting justification when additional funds are needed and analyze impacts of regulatory funding thresholds. You will also be responsible for communicating critical issues as necessary and conduct public meetings, education meetings and technical review committees as well as prepare responses to various inquiries, reports and press releases.

1. Broad knowledge of all phases of Civil Engineer functions with special emphasis and professional knowledge of engineering design/construction and program management.
