Description: You will start, operate, adjust, and stop single or multiple fuel power boilers and auxiliary, pollution control, and other equipment in a steam or high temperature water boiler plant. You will maintain, repair, and test a variety of complex equipment and systems. You will plan and lay out installation, repair, and/or modification of a variety of complex equipment and systems. You will also troubleshoot single and multiple fuel power boilers and associated auxiliary and pollution control equipment. You will utilize established safety practices, rules, regulations, and procedures to maintain safe and clean work environment. As required, may train and/or guide other personnel in performance of duties. When required and within your skill set, may be required to work outside their trades. After training, you will hold and use the United States Government Purchase Card (GPC), to purchase material and tools critical to the mission usually at short notice.

Please provide detailed work experience as it relates to the required competencies listed below, as this will be used to determine your qualification for this position.

1. Knowledge of and experience applying technical practices in order to perform various operational repairs and preventive maintenance on boilers, auxiliary, and pollution control equipment; and of steam or high temperature hot water boiler plant equipment including single or multiple fuel power boilers fueled by oil or natural gas, or a combination of these fuels; auxiliary pollution control; and other auxiliary equipment.
2. Knowledge of and experience applying safety regulations, practices, and procedures.
3. Skill in troubleshooting complex problems through application of prescribed test procedures and equipment.
4. Skill in the use of measuring instruments to determine operational status and make necessary adjustments.
5. Ability to interpret diagrams, drawings, operating manuals, or special facility procedures to be followed during emergencies, equipment failures, or system malfunctions.
6. Ability to operate auxiliary equipment and pollution control equipment; to operate power boilers using computer controlled equipment that produce steam or high temperature hot water; and to perform preventive maintenance and various operational repairs.

OTHER SIGNIFICANT FACTORS:

1. The work will require the employee to drive a motor vehicle. An appropriate, valid United Kingdom driver's license is required.
2. Educated to GCSE or equivalent completed and passed an approved apprenticeship or attained a **minimum of a NVQ level 3** in an appropriate discipline.
3. Experience in maintenance and repair of industrial heating systems preferred/desirable
4. Employee may be required to work rotating shifts. Emergency overtime may be required but is not guaranteed. Individuals may be required to work through their lunch break in the event of an emergency.
6. A pre-employment physical examination will be required.
