### **COVID Prevention**

- Monitor for symptoms of COVID-19. Stay home if sick & call MDG (01638 52 8010/226-8010) for eval
- 1 in 3 people who have COVID-19 have no symptoms & can spread it without realizing it. Critical to:
  - Maximize ventilation indoors & ensure 6 feet social distancing
  - Wear mask IAW installation COVID directives & local requirements
  - Wash/sanitize hands & common surfaces frequently
  - Comply with isolation & quarantine rules & directions
  - Get both your COVID jabs! US CDC recommends all age 12 years and older including people who are pregnant, breastfeeding, trying to get pregnant now, or who might become pregnant in the future - get vaccinated. Schedule at https://informatics-stage.health.mil/COVAX/. See COVID vaccine FAQs.
    - US CDC recommends a 3rd dose of Pfizer vaccine following primary Pfizer series for age 65 or older, and ages 50-64 with certain underlying health conditions. Full vaccination mandatory for USAF Active Duty NLT 2 Nov. AD vaccine line scheduled for 14 Oct at RAFL Gym.
  - Follow travel safety guidance & plan travel w/ updated pre/post risk assessments

## **UK Updates**

Highest regional rates continue in ages 5-19 (50% of all cases this week), cases continued to increase significantly in those age 10-19 - 1.7% of 10-14 year olds tested positive for COVID this past week.

- England revised its "traffic light" system effective 4 Oct 21, with fully vaccinated arrivals from most (non-"red-list") countries not requiring pre-travel test, post-travel quarantine or Day 8 test. Those 18 and over who are not fully vaccinated require pre-travel and day 2/8 post-arrival tests, as well as 10-day quarantine. Red-list arrivals, regardless of age or vaccine status, continue to require pre-arrival and day 2/8 post-arrival COVID tests, as well as 10 day quarantine. **Destinations have** entry restrictions/requirements & must be confirmed when making travel plans via DoD Foreign Clearance Guide, US State Dept & UK resources.
- US cases high throughout country but continued decreased by 12%, deaths further decreased by 8%. Hospitalizations remain high but continued decrease. Highest case rates in AK, ID, ND, MT, WV & WY.

Europe cases stable this week but expected to increase in next 2 weeks; areas of concern include Bulgaria, Croatia, Estonia, Georgia, Ireland, Latvia, Lithuania, Romania, Slovakia, & UK.

### **Protect Yourself and Others:**

**Get vaccinated & wear a mask.** Tri-base area is experiencing moderate-to-high community transmission. Installation directives require mask wear in certain indoor settings regardless of vaccine status, due to increased infectivity of Delta variant.

**Get vaccinated for COVID-19 and Influenza.** Annual flu vaccine is recommended for ages 6 months and up; mandatory for AD and some civilian personnel.
