The 422nd Civil Engineering Squadron is looking for someone to perform inspections and surveillance on a variety of Liaises directly with clients to identify requirements and obtain and act on feedback. Maintains daily logs and safety reports addressing the progress of construction and the administration of the contract. Also assist planners in developing the Utilities and Facilities Activity Management Plans, which includes annual work plans for both corrective and preventive maintenance programs best fit for the portfolio of facilities and infrastructure on record. Incumbent will coordinate with contractor representatives concerning work plans, scheduling interpretation of plans and specifications, selection of work methods, and acceptability of materials and workmanship to ensure compliance with contract requirements. Duties will also include performing as a technical consultant to the Operations Flight Director, DIO, and Engineering Flight, inspecting equipment and materials and gathering information in order to compile written inspection reports.

Knowledge and Experience Required

Applicants must demonstrate the following:

1. Knowledge of UK construction inspection practices and procedures involved in the inspection of building materials, workmanship, utilities the installation of systems; and the practical methods and techniques of engineering principles relating to complex construction practices and procedures is desired.
2. Must have knowledge of UK regulations for electrical aspects of major construction projects. Mechanical and structural knowledge is desired.
3. Knowledge of inspection and safety practices and procedures in the UK construction industry is desired.
4. Knowledge of engineering and architectural plans and specifications to read and interpret construction requirements is desired.
5. Knowledge of construction trades, algebra, geometry, and trigonometry is desired.
6. Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing, gathering information to compile written inspection reports.

Other Important Information

- Hours of work: Start & end times may be modified due to mission needs and in accordance with organization's flexible working policies.
- Will be required to handle and safeguard sensitive information in accordance with applicable US and UK laws, rules, and regulations.
- Must obtain and maintain the appropriate security clearance.
- May be assigned other duties that are appropriate to the grade and skill set of the employee.
- May be required to travel by military and/or civilian aircraft in the performance of official duties or attend necessary training. Position may be coded as mission essential.
- A 6 month probationary period will be required.
- Overtime may be required.
- May be required to travel overnight to US or other countries in the performance of official duties or attend necessary training.

Other significant facts pertaining to this position are:

1. This position requires the knowledge of numerous UK regulations and codes of work. From time to time, there are various courses that must be attended to keep up to date with new practices, materials and safety legislation.
2. The position requires the use of a hand-held two-way radio or alternative method of on-site communication.
3. Must hold, or be capable of obtaining, relevant specialized certifications for various types of plant and equipment for which the employee has oversight responsibilities.
4. May be required to wear personal protective equipment when performing on-site inspections.
5. Employee is required to be familiar with software packages currently in use by 422 CES and the Facility Support Contractor, training may be required in order to obtain the necessary proficiency.
6. Applicant must hold an HND/HNC/BTEC, City and Guilds, NVQ or equivalent qualification in an appropriate discipline, together with a minimum of three years UK work experience in the trade. A bachelor's degree is not required.
