Job Description

This role involves installing, maintaining, and repairing electrical systems and their components. The position requires inspecting and testing new and existing wiring, troubleshooting faults, and making repairs based on technical drawings and manuals. The individual must adhere to all safety regulations, maintain a clean work environment, and document all actions taken.

Qualifications and Key skills

- City & Guilds/ NVQ level 3 Award in the requirements electrical installations BS 7671 18th Edition Regulation
 - City and Guilds/NVQ Level 3 Award in an appropriate discipline (i.e Inspection, Testing & Certification of Electrical Installations City & Guilds 2391)
 - A valid UK CAT B driving license
1. Knowledge of electrical and electronic theory, safety regulations, and the technical practices required to plan, install, troubleshoot, and test complete electrical systems using a variety of test instruments like multimeters, meggers, and circuit analyzers.
 2. Skill in using and maintaining hand tools, and troubleshooting and tracing hard-to-locate defects or problems.

3. Ability to use electrical drawings, blueprints, engineering drawings, and wiring diagrams and to install, troubleshoot, repair, and maintain various electrical systems, controls, and equipment.

Conditions of employment

1. You will be required to handle and safeguard sensitive information in accordance with applicable US and UK laws, rules and regulations. This position may also be coded as mission essential.
2. You may be required to travel by military and/or civilian aircraft, and you may also be required to travel to the US or other country, in the performance of official duties or attend necessary training.
3. You will be required to complete a 6-month probationary period.
4. Start & end times may be modified due to mission needs and in accordance with organization's flexible working policies. Emergency overtime may be required.
5. and you may be assigned other duties not included in this position description, but that are appropriate to the grade and skill set of the incumbent.
6. You must be able to communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
7. May work with hazardous materials such as asbestos or accumulated waste. Employee will be required to wear protective clothing and gear on these occasions. First aid training for electric shock and fire safety training is required.
8. Position requires the ability to discern colors, contrast, and depth. A pre-employment is required for this position; this will be conducted at RAF Lakenheath.
9. The incumbent will be expected to obtain ATEX/DSEAR internal and external training certification within one year.

NOTE: You will require a security clearance and a right to work in the UK
