Job Description:

The primary purpose of this position is to process a variety of recyclables and operate a variety of gasoline, diesel, or electric powered wheeled vehicles typically having a gross vehicle weight of up to 7500kg on the installation or on the public roads in a full range of traffic conditions and at highway speeds to transport cargo. You will also Also operate forklifts to facilitate cargo loading/unloading and sorts, stacks and processes recyclable materials

You will assist with the collection, sorting, and processing of recyclable materials from facilities located across all RAF Mildenhall properties and drive one or more types of medium trucks such as platform trucks, van trucks, stake trucks, or dump trucks to collect, process and deliver solid waste and recyclables coinciding with the Qualified Recycling Program, and transport supplies, materials, and equipment

In addition, you will operate one or more electric, LPG, or diesel-powered forklift trucks to facilitate loading and unloading duties and perform operator maintenance, such as checking fluid levels and air pressure in tires, cleaning and washing of vehicles, and performing inspection checklists to ensure safe and proper operation. You will utilize safety practices and procedures following established safety rules and regulations and maintain a safe and clean work environment, maintaining records and documenting required action.

Qualifications and Key skills:

A valid UK Category C1 driving license is required for this position

1. Knowledge of operating one or more gasoline, diesel, or electric powered wheeled vehicles with a GVW of up to 7500kg such as platform trucks, stake rucks, dump trucks, and cargo vans.
2. Knowledge of cargo handling and hauling and techniques for safeguarding and protecting cargo.
3. Knowledge of traffic and safety regulations, practices, and procedures pertaining to motor vehicle and forklift operation.
4. Knowledge of and skill in operating one or more electric LPG, or diesel-powered forklift typically capable of lifting less than 7500kg and the ability to judge aisles, doorways, loads and load balance, and operate controls to maneuver forklift trucks
5. Knowledge of accepted warehousing methods, procedures, and material handling techniques; and of warehousing functions such as material receiving, storage, issuing, and preservation.
6. Ability to judge road/traffic conditions and read maps to determine the shortest and safest route and meet pickup and delivery deadlines and schedules
7. Ability to interpret instructions, specifications, etc. related to motor vehicle, forklift, and power take-off unit operation and preventative maintenance.

Conditions of employment

1. You will be required to handle and safeguard sensitive information in accordance with applicable US and UK laws, rules and regulations. This position may also be coded as mission essential.
2. You may be required to travel by military and/or civilian aircraft, and you may also be required to travel to the US or other country, in the performance of official duties or attend necessary training.
3. You will be required to complete a 6-month probationary period.
4. Start & end times may be modified due to mission needs and in accordance with organization's flexible working policies. Overtime may be required and you may be assigned other duties not included in this position description, but that are appropriate to the grade and skill set of the incumbent.
5. You must be able to communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
6. Position requires the ability to discern colors, contrast, and depth.
7. Shift work and working at the weekend may be required. You may be required to work other than normal duty hours, which may include evenings, weekends, and/or holidays.
8. You are required to operate forklifts to facilitate cargo loading/unloading. Experience is desirable.
9. This position requires a physical/medical examination. The physical requirements of this position as determined by the manager are: Physical effort is moderate. Work requires reaching, turning, or moving hands, arms, feet, and legs to operate hand and foot controls. Associated duties require stooping, bending, and climbing. Lifts and carries objects weighing up to 40 pounds and heavier objects with assistance

NOTE: You will require a security clearance and a right to work in the UK
