DESCRIPTION:	<p>The primary purpose of this position is to work with a crew of military and civilian Electrical Systems Technicians on the installation, testing, repair, troubleshooting, general maintenance and calibration of various electrical systems, controls and equipment on industrial/commercial buildings on base. You will install, repair or replace, modify loads and test new and existing electrical lines, circuits, systems, fittings, distribution boards, switches, breakers, and controls located in and near installation buildings and structures. You will troubleshoot problem areas and inspect for defective equipment and faulty wiring. You will use and maintain various types of hand held and power tools.</p>												
GENERAL EXPERIENCE:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Knowledge of safety regulations, practices and procedures. 2. Knowledge of technical practices in order to plan, lay out, install, modify, troubleshoot, and repair a variety of complete systems. 3. Knowledge of electrical and electronic theory and instruments used in shop and trade practices and of electrical equipment, i.e. test lamps, multimeters, circuit analyzers, circuit breaker testers, voltage recording meters, meggers, watt meters, ohmmeters, and ammeters. 4. Skill in using and maintaining hand tools such as, screwdrivers, pliers, wire cutters, strippers, cable pullers, drills, soldering irons and manual or power conduit pipes and threaders. 5. Skill in troubleshooting and tracing hard-to-locate defects or problems. 6. Ability to use electrical drawings, blueprints, engineering drawings, and wiring diagrams and to install, troubleshoot, repair, and maintain various electrical systems, controls and equipment without more than normal supervision. 												
OTHER SIGNIFICANT FACTS:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The work will require the employee to drive a motor vehicle. Minimum category 'B' driver's license will be required for this position. 2. The work may require the employee to operate (with proper training) specialized vehicles, such as motorized maintenance platforms, "High Reaches", or other types of lifts. 3.
