About you:

The successful applicant will have knowledge and experience of applying safety regulations, practises and procedures, as well as the knowledge and experience of performing technical practises in order to plan, lay out, install, modify, troubleshoot, and repair a variety of complete

systems. This position will also involve applying electrical and electronic theories and instruments used in shop and trade practises, and of electrical equipment i.e test lamps, multi-meters, circuit analysers, circuit breakers, testers, voltage recording meters, meggers, watt meters, ohmmeters and ammeters. You will also have skills in using and maintaining hand tools, troubleshooting and tracing hard to locate defects or problems. You will have the ability to install, modify, test, repair, troubleshoot, and maintain high voltage electrical power-controlling equipment and/or distribution lines without more than normal supervision.

Qualification requirements:

- **NVQ Level 3 electrical technical qualification**
- **18th edition IET wiring regulations**
- **Knowledge of and experience working on motors, controls and operations of boiler systems is desired. Applicant must be willing to attain certification after accepting the position.**

Certificates must be submitted for your application to be valid.

Other significant facts about the role:

You will be required to handle and safeguard sensitive information in accordance with applicable US and UK laws, rules and regulations. You may be required to travel by military and/or civilian aircraft and you may also be required to travel to the US or other country, in the performance of official duties or attend necessary training, this position may also be coded as mission essential. You will be required to complete a **6-month** probationary period. Overtime may be required, and you may be assigned other duties not included in this position description, but that are appropriate to the grade and skill set of the incumbent.
