In addition, you will use computers/computer software such as information management programs, computer aided design and drafting (CADD) programs, maintenance management system, and project tracking programs to solve engineering problems and facilitate work. You will be required to comply with health, safety, and environmental rules and procedures and performs work in a manner that enhances the safety of the work environment. Your hours of work will be **37.5 hours per week on a fixed schedule** (Mon-Fri) where start & end times may be modified due to mission needs and in accordance with the organization's flexible working policies.

**About you:**

You need to have a professional knowledge of multi-disciplinary engineering concepts, principles, and practices and be familiar with engineering disciplines and architecture. You will require knowledge of program planning and budgeting cycles, financial control and budget systems, and management, as well as of work classifications and the regulatory and statutory restrictions on the expenditures of appropriated and non-appropriated funds. In addition, you require a knowledge of automated data processing concepts, systems capabilities, and economic usage to effectively accomplish assigned functions and knowledge of health, safety, and environmental requirements as outlined in applicable standards, regulations, and/or technical orders. You must be able to plan, conduct, and record site/facility surveys and inspections, and plan and organize work; analyze, interpret, and apply rules, regulations, and procedures in a variety of situations; recommend timely and economical solutions; coordinate with other engineering disciplines and architects; communicate effectively both orally and in writing; and maintain good working relations.

**Qualification requirements:**

- A degree in Engineering or combination of college level education (HND/HNC/BTEC, City and Guilds, NVQ, in an appropriate discipline e.g. Building and Civil Engineering/Mechanical & Electrical Engineering discipline and/or Construction Management) together with specialized experience of building construction project management procedures.
- A valid UK Driving License – Category B

Certificates and licenses must be submitted for your application to be valid.

**Other significant facts about the role:**

You will be required to handle and safeguard sensitive information in accordance with applicable US and UK laws, rules and regulations. You may be required to travel by military and/or civilian aircraft, and you may also be required to travel to the US or other country, in the performance of official duties or attend necessary training, this position may also be coded as mission essential. You will be required to complete a **6-month** probationary period. Overtime may be required, and you may be assigned other duties not included in this position description, but that are appropriate to the grade and skill set of the incumbent. You must be able to communicate effectively both orally and in writing. You may be required to act as project liaison with the Defence Infrastructure Organization or other design agencies as required. The work requires the employee to access facilities and infrastructure which may require climbing on, crawling under or extensive walking at construction sites, hard hat areas or other base areas. The Local National Direct Hire (LNDH) Program does not participate in regular drug testing, however positions covered by this document may be subject to drug testing upon reasonable suspicion of substance abuse, and safety mishap or accident testing.

**All successful applicants will require a security clearance and a right to work in the UK.**
