Job Description

As the Senior Installations and Logistics Officer, you will be the primary point of contact for all installation and logistics matters on-site. You will be responsible for promptly and accurately reporting any facility or logistical issues, planned or unplanned, that could negatively impact operations or personnel to leadership from the Facilities Control Centre. Overseeing the Facilities Infrastructure Operations and the Operations & Maintenance Facilities Control Centre, you will ensure compliance with all regulations and meet customer needs. You will also establish and implement requirements for operations and maintenance activities, aligning them with organizational goals and mission requirements, while managing project programming. Furthermore, you will represent Base Operations at various levels, including installation, Wing, Higher Headquarters, and other relevant organizations.

Qualifications and Key skills for the position.

A valid UK driver's license (Category B) is required, in addition to:

One of the following:

- An accredited Bachelors or honors degree in engineering or technology
- An accredited Higher National Certificate (HNC) or Higher National Diploma (HND) in engineering or technology started before September 1999
- An HNC or HND started after September 1999 (but before September 2010 in the case of HNC) or a Foundation Degree in engineering or technology, plus appropriate further learning to degree level (i.e. NVQ Level 6)
- A National Vocational Qualification (NVQ) or Scottish Vocational Qualification (SVQ) at level 4, plus appropriate further learning to degree level (i.e. NVQ Level 6)
- Equivalent qualifications or accredited apprenticeships, or at an equivalent level in a relevant national or international qualifications framework.

*All qualifications are to be in the appropriate field for the position.

**All qualifications are required to be accompanied by at least 1 year's specialized experience.

In order to qualify you must demonstrate in your CV or application the following key skills.

Successful candidates must demonstrate a comprehensive understanding of multidisciplinary engineering theories, standard construction and contracting regulations, and safety/security protocols. Strong program management, financial planning, and Budgeting Systems (PPBS) knowledge are essential, alongside the ability to effectively lead, mentor, and organize personnel. Additionally, the role demands superior oral and written communication skills to interface with senior government and industry officials, and the technical skill to evaluate and integrate cutting-edge technologies into the design, operation, and maintenance of natural and built installation infrastructure.

Conditions of employment

- You will be required to handle and safeguard sensitive information in accordance with applicable US and UK laws, rules and regulations. This position may also be coded as mission essential.
- You may be required to travel by military and/or civilian aircraft, and you may also be required to travel to the US or other country, in the performance of official duties or attend necessary training.
- You will be required to complete a 6-month probationary period.
- Start & end times may be modified due to mission needs and in accordance with organization's flexible working policies. The work pattern is a rotating 12-hour shift (as rostered) which will cover both a day and night shift pattern Overtime may be required, and you may be assigned other duties not included in this position description, but that are appropriate to the grade and skill set of the incumbent.
- You must be able to communicate effectively both orally and in writing and must obtain and maintain the appropriate security clearance.
- The Local National Direct Hire (LNDH) Program does not participate in regular drug testing; however, positions covered by this document may be subject to drug testing upon reasonable suspicion of substance abuse, and safety mishap or accident testing.

NOTE: You will require a security clearance and a right to work in the UK

This position may have certain restrictions on US citizens including US dual nationals due to the Status of Forces Agreement.
