Homeschooling can be a logical choice for families in the military, providing a stable environment in the midst of frequent change. While assigned in the United Kingdom, families fall under U.S. federal regulations versus state & homeschoolers are not required to register with the base or a state. Although, it is not required to register with the base or a state, it is highly *recommended* to follow the guidance of your home-of-record or another state.
