In February 1951, the first B-29s were stationed at RAF Mildenhall, when the 93 BG rotated out and the 830th Bombardment Squadron, from the 509th Bombardment Wing took its place. This was followed in May 1951 by the first B-50s to operate out of RAF Mildenhall from the 49th Bombardment Squadron, who replaced the 830 BS.

Strategic Air Command established the 3910th ABG to take over the responsibilities of the 7511 ABG on October 1, 1951. In addition to support for the deployed SAC units, the 3910 ABG also took administrative control of RAF Mildenhall from the RAF's No. 3 Group. However, the No. 3 Group remained on RAF Mildenhall until 1967.
